Kirstenbosch places a strong emphasis on the cultivation of indigenous plants.

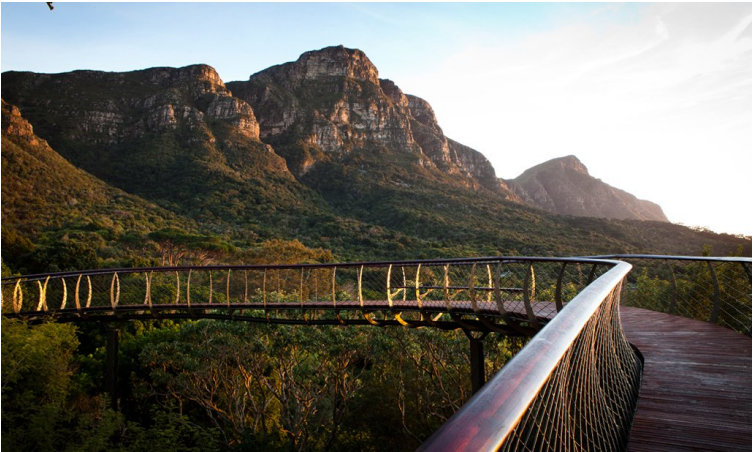
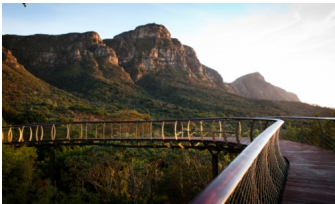
